Game: Kim's Best Cat

1. Preparation: Print the game board. If you want to re-use it, laminate it and give the student erasable white-board markers to write on the board.
2. Teacher dictates the sounds of letters learned in today's and previous lessons. The student hears the sound of the letter, says the name of the letter, and writes it in a blank space on the board. Continue until all the blanks are filled.
2. Student throws a dice and moves forward on the board. Every time he lands on a letter he says the sound of the letter and a word with this letter.
3. When he gets to the end of the game he gets a prize.
