Bingo Game

Preparation: Glue onto construction paper (and optionally laminate – if you do, make sure you leave enough margin around the edges for a good seal) the two bingo boards and the table of words to cut up. (You can print two copies of the colorful "BINGO" label on the last page and put them on the back of the boards, to be fancy-see page 4.) Cut up the table of bingo words and put them in a bag. You also need buttons or beans for markers.

Play: Each player gets a Bingo board. Place a marker on the star in the center (wild square). The learner pulls words from the bag and reads them aloud (for his turn and for yours). Place a marker on the word when it is read. The first player to get five squares in a line (vertical, horizontal or diagonal) wins.
