"This kitten?"















"Yes! Yes! That kitten!"

Game: Describe and Caption the Pictures

Cut up the story, cutting apart the pictures and their texts.

You can use the story text or prepare new captions for the pictures, such as:

Yetta is sick in bed

A kind kid Ben has kittens

Yetta sat in her bed

Ben picks a kitten

Yetta pats her cat's neck

Yetta isn't sick

Glue pictures and captions / story text onto stiff paper (lamination optional).
