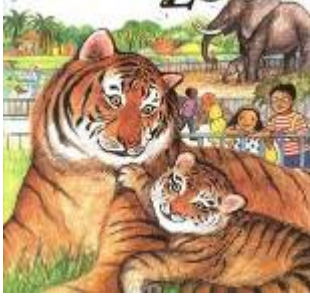
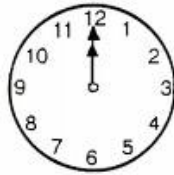


Look for the Food



David, Vicky and Bob are on a school trip at the zoo.

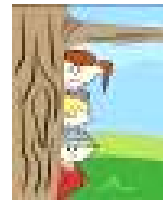
At noon, they feel hungry.

They look at Mrs. Boon like she is from the moon. "But we're hungry!" "Just look," she tells them.















Soon Vicky yells, "Look, in this tree there is a door! There is a room inside the tree! I see a raccoon. He has our food!" They all run to Vicky.
