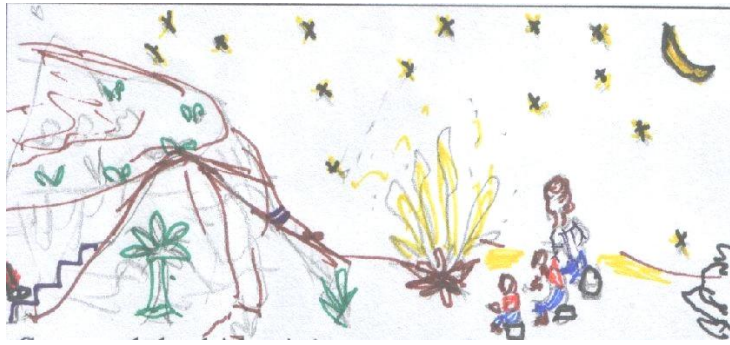


### Take Care
