



Ursula asks, "Is there a problem, Aviva?" "Don't look in your purse! Keep looking at the street," says Aviva.

Dominoes: Match word to its Hebrew definition.

Directions: Print the pages on cardstock and cut out each card separately.

1. Shuffle the domino cards face-down and draw seven cards each. Leave the remaining cards in a pile.
2. Decide which player goes first. That player places a card face up on the table.
3. The second player then plays a card that matches a definition on either side of the first card.
4. Take turns playing cards that match the word on one of the open ends of the domino chain.
5. Draw a card from the pile if you can't play any.
6. The player that finishes his/her cards first wins. Alternatively, if neither player can make a move, the player with the fewest cards wins.
