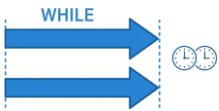


The bag was heavy when Mark grabbed it.

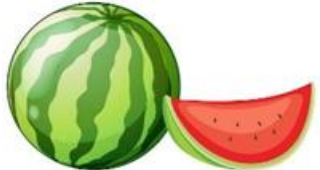
