"Help! My kittens aren't dry!"



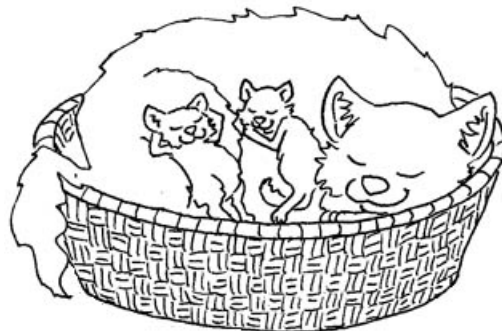
The kids let the kittens in.
