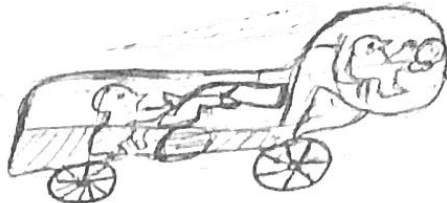
David: "Hello, Mike, good morning."

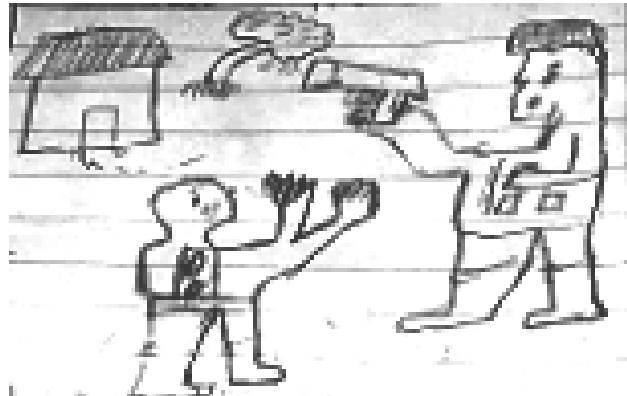
Mike ran the sugar factory, but he secretly sold the sugar for dollars and kept the dollars for himself.

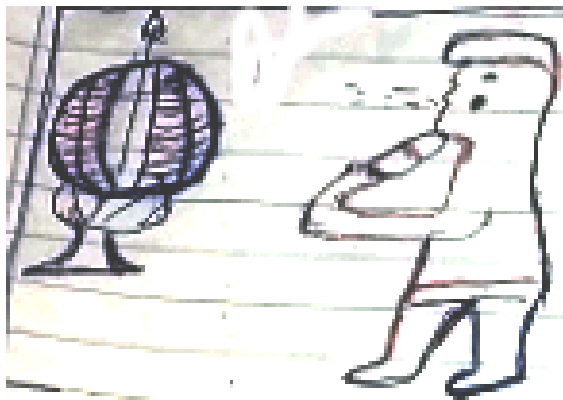
David calls muscular General Solomon on his cellular phone to help catch Mike the thief.

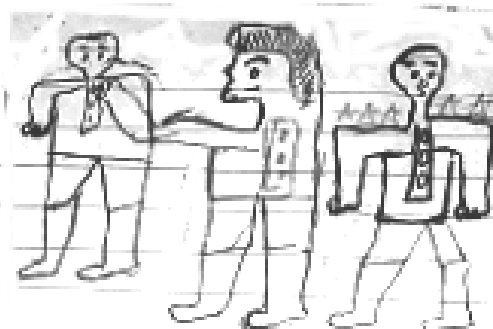
Muscular General Solomon catches Mike by the collar and brings him out of the cellar.
