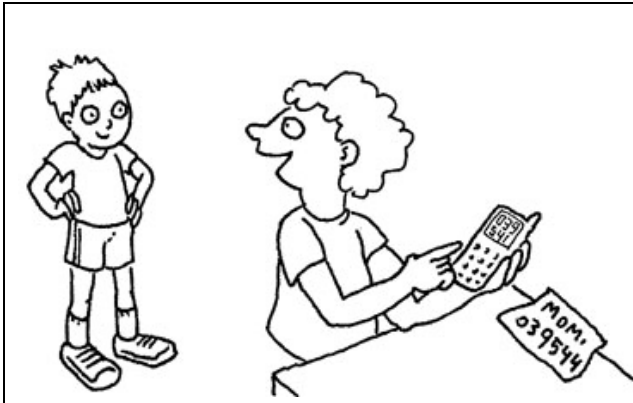
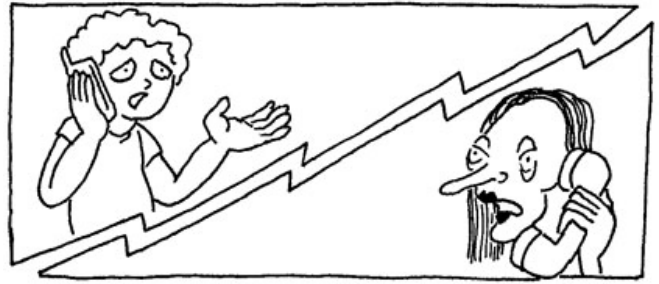


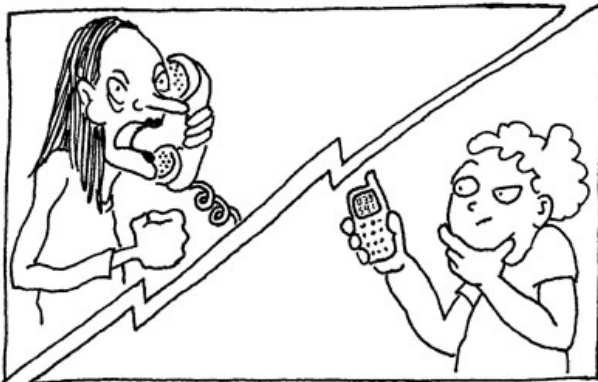
### David Misdials to an Unkind Woman

He calls his mom, but he misdials.



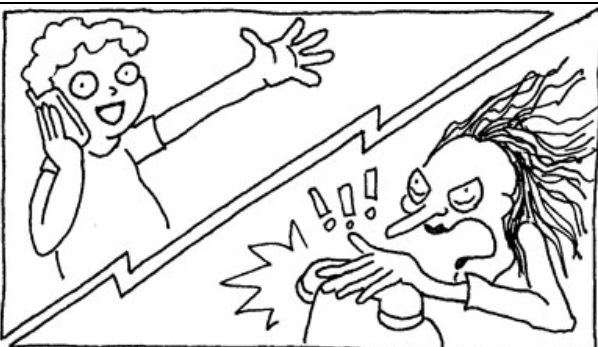
"Hi, Mom, it's me. I'm going to visit my friend Stan, O.K.?"

"No, I'm Mrs. Bing," said the woman.















"I've made a mistake!" David tells her.
