

Sam, Pam and the Crab



Sam and Pam ran in the sand in the camp.




Sam and Pam met a crab.




The crab bit Pam's skin:

"Families" Game

Goal: To collect the four cards in the "family" with the same picture at the top of the card. (See key below for the family name represented by the picture.)

The student has to read the words to get the card, so he is very motivated.

How to play: Example: Do you have the picture "crab"?; other player answers "Yes/No" - If yes, "do you have "met"?" Yes/No

When the player has the four cards in the family with the same picture, he says "I have a set" and he has to make a sentence using the four words. He can add words and if it's difficult for him you can show him the picture without the sentence.
