

A Trip to the Ocean




Early one morning, I drove to the ocean. The weather was great, it was nice and sunny.




I read a book, while I ate the fresh bread I got at the market.




I took a break from reading. I put on my new snorkel set, and dove head first into the water.

Preparation: Make cards containing the following words from the lesson, with the symbol for the category (long e, short e, long a, other) on the back of each card.

Cut the cards out on the solid lines (front and back attached).

Fold back on the gray/dotted line so the symbol and word are back-to-back, and glue.

Laminate the board and cards, if you'd like.

Play: Player rolls the die, moves to a square, and when he lands on a symbol, chooses a card from the pile with the matching symbol and reads the word aloud.
