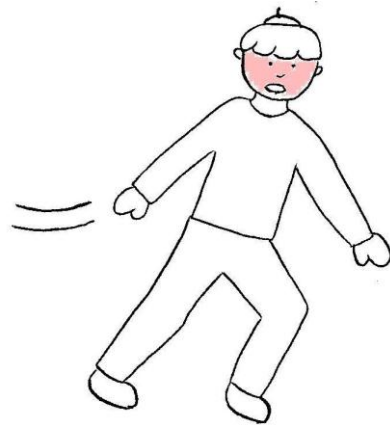
Mother and Father dance fast to the song.



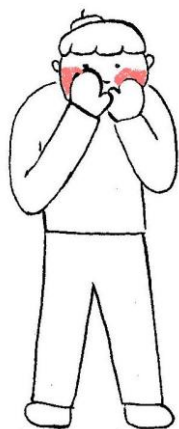
Father spins Mother to the nice music.



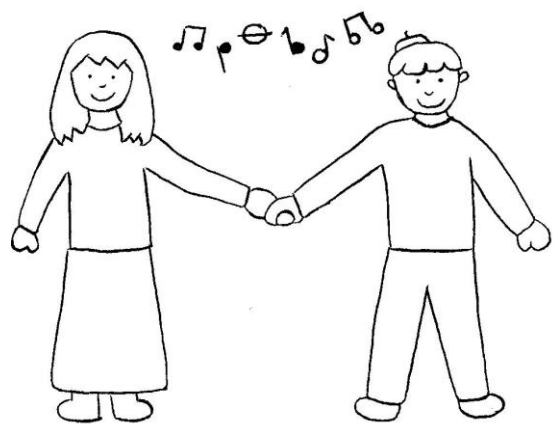
Father dances fast: he hops and drops. He slips and trips.



Father's face is getting red as he races all over the place.










