He is Batman.



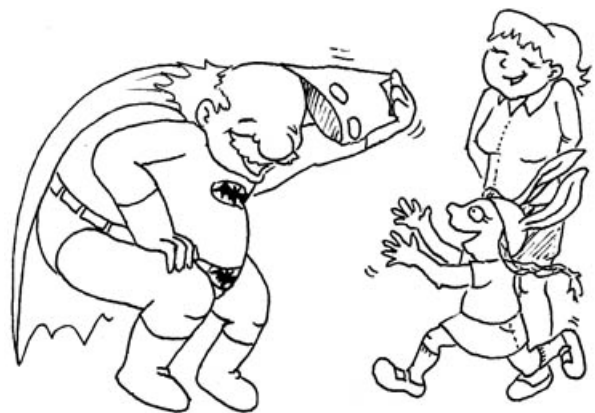
The kids met him. Ann hid behind Nan.

this mask."













