Because the fawn loved strawberries, he ate lots for breakfast every day.



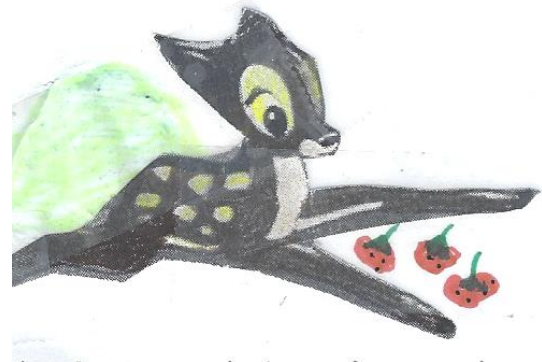
Just as the fawn got to the strawberry bush, a hawk swooped down with a saw in his jaw, because he loved strawberries too!

The hawk took out his straw with his claw and drank from all the fallen strawberries. Then he flew away.















The fawn crawled out from under the bush and said "Wow, that was close! It's good the hawk left some strawberries for me!" And he ate his breakfast.

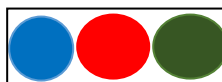
