

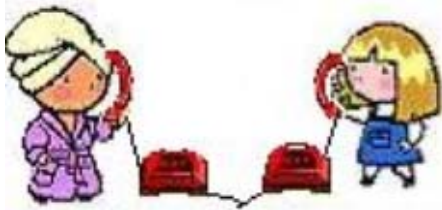
Rose and Hope

She makes tones on her trombone.



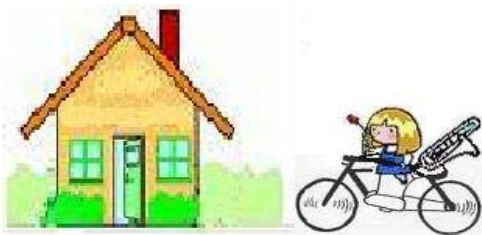
Hope is also lonely.

She makes a snack.
















Rose rode to Hope's home.

garden and she takes her trombone.



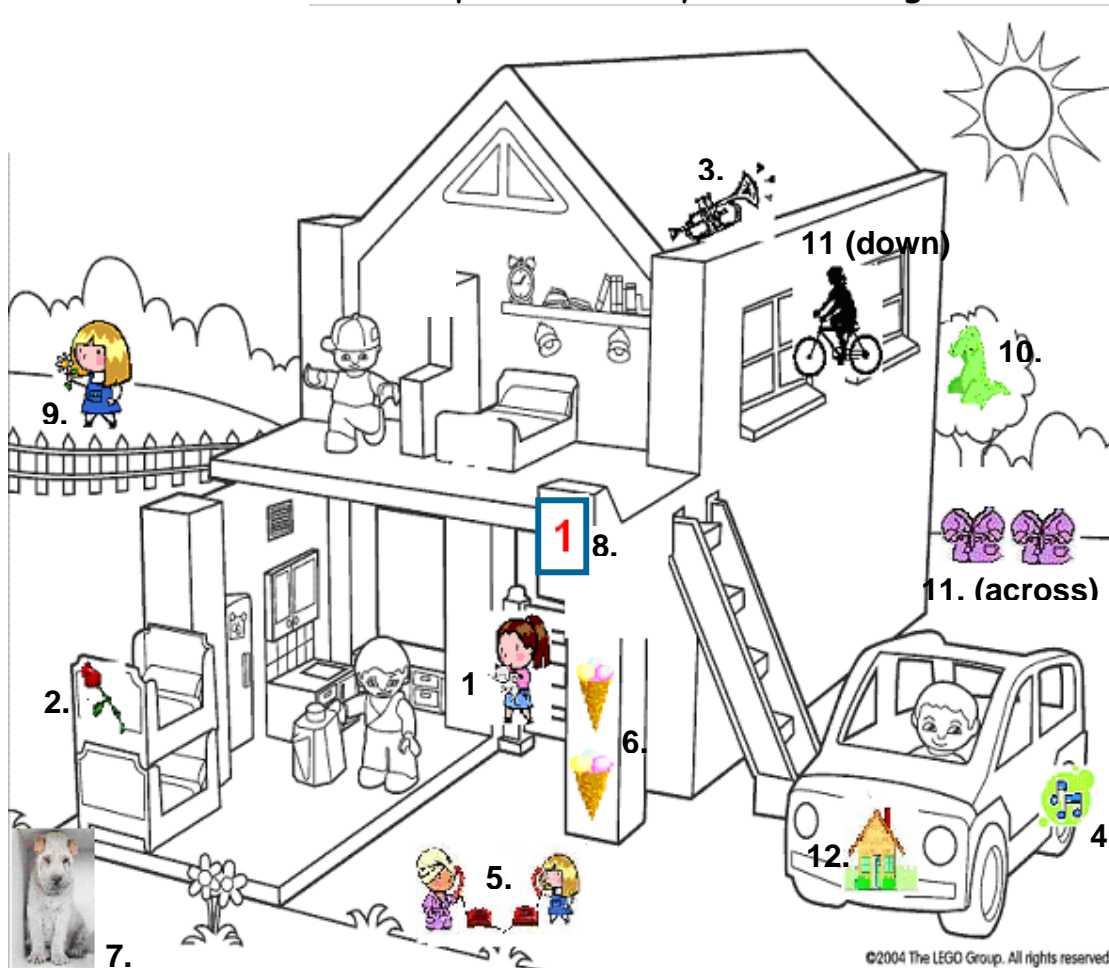
Rose and Hope lick their cones.

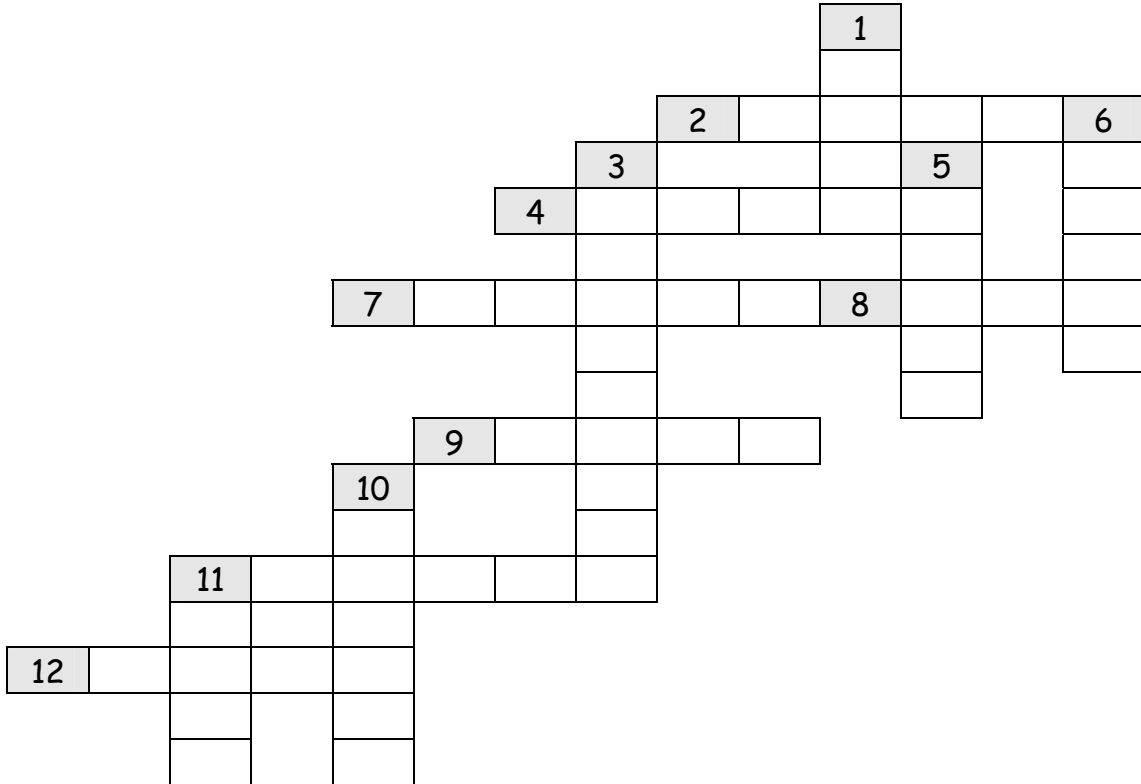
Find the Hidden Words
