

Crocodiles game

Preparation:

Make "stones" out of plastic material called "mapal" in Hebrew. Write the words or letters on the stone. Put them on the floor the way stones can make a crossing path over the river.

How to play the game:

The child / children should cross the river full of dangerous crocodiles, stepping on the stones and reading the words. If the child makes a mistake the crocodile eats him up (the teacher opens the arms like the big mouth of a crocodile), the child goes back to the first word and tries again or the turn passes to another child. The one who succeeds crossing the river becomes the crocodile and the joins the crocodile-teacher. That's the highlight of the game!
