Shimon went to fish for fish, but he didn't find fish. He fishes a dish!



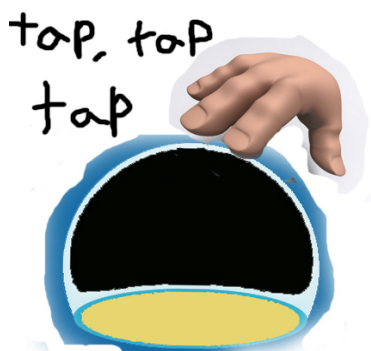
He went by ship to Shane's fish shop. He brings the dish, but not the fish.



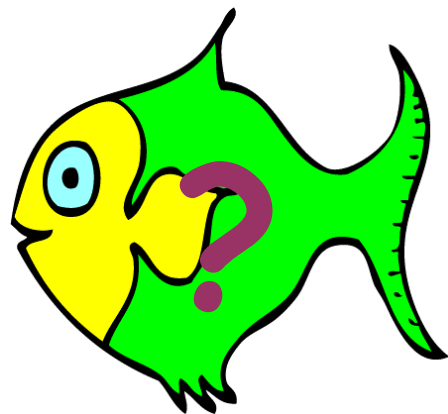
Shane, the fish shop salesman, is quite mad.
