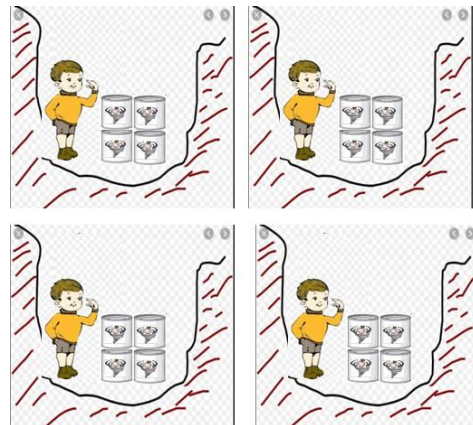

### Game: Jeopardy

Download the accompanying PowerPoint file "Jeopardy 3x3.pptx" accompanying this lesson. Choose from the menu, Slide Show > From beginning.

#### Instructions for play:

1. The student chooses a category and an amount.
2. The game host clicks once on the appropriate square, and the sum is automatically hidden
3. The game host clicks again on the square, and the answer is displayed. The answer shows a clue picture, and sometimes some text
4. The student gives the correct question for the answer
5. The game host clicks one on the question, and the answer is displayed
6. The game host clicks once on the answer, and you are returned to the game board.
