The kids ran along the path to the king. He is still standing by his cake. He is mad.



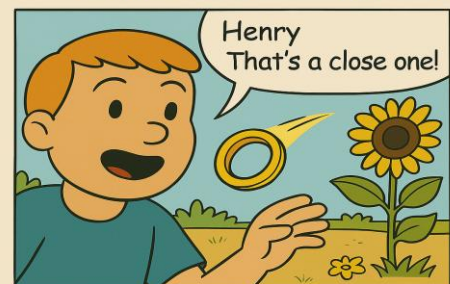
Henry said, "A prong and a bit of string are in the sand!" The kids are standing by a nest. A parrot sits among the thin sticks in the nest. It has the ring.

Tic-Tac-Toe Word Game - Instructions

These Tic-Tac-Toe boards can be used in many fun and educational ways to enhance reading, vocabulary, and critical thinking. Below are several ways to play using the same board.

1. Read & Mark

Goal: Practice word recognition

How to Play:

- Players take turns.
- Before placing a mark (X or O), a player must read the word aloud.
- If the word is read correctly, they mark the square. If not, they lose the turn.
- The first to get 3 in a row wins.

2. Use It in a Sentence

Goal: Vocabulary comprehension

How to Play:

- Players choose a square and use the word in a sentence.
- If the sentence is correct, they can mark the square.
- Continue until someone gets 3 in a row.

3. Act It Out (Charades Style)

Goal: Improve comprehension through movement

How to Play:

- A player chooses a word and acts it out silently.
- If the partner guesses correctly, they mark that square.
- First to 3 in a row wins.

4. Draw It

Goal: Connect word to visual meaning

How to Play:

- A player picks a word and draws a quick sketch of it.
- If their partner guesses the word, they mark the square.
- Win by getting 3 in a row.

5. Definition Match

Goal: Reinforce meanings

How to Play:

- The teacher reads a definition aloud.
- Students must find and mark the matching word on the board.
- If correct, they can place their mark.

6. Rhyming Challenge

Goal: Phonemic awareness

How to Play:

- The player reads the word aloud and gives a rhyming word(ex: ring-king)
- If it's a real word and correct, they place their mark.
