5. The winner is the player with the most cards.



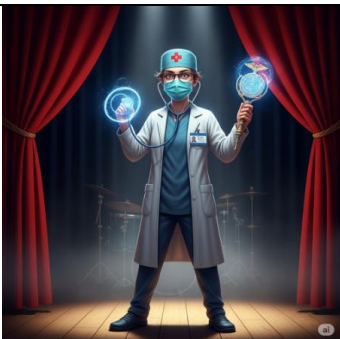

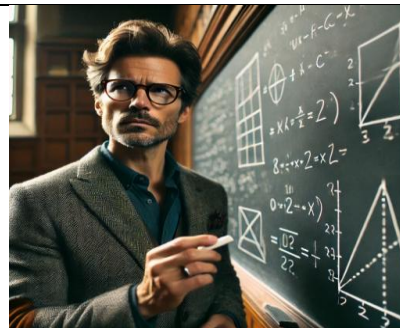

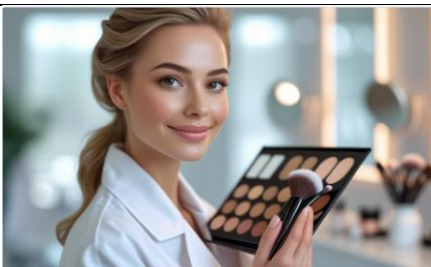
