

Lesson 5 Word Practice
 Matching Game "Puzzle"

Preparation:

Cut out the squares on the dotted lines only (don't cut out the triangles).

Options: You can enlarge the puzzle, glue your puzzle onto colored paper or cardboard and laminate. You can make giant squares on stiff board or Bristol.

To play: match the rhyming words, placing them together (the edges of their squares touching). Assemble the puzzle into a 3X3 square so that every word only touches a rhyming word. (There are lots of "right ways" to assemble the puzzle, since the words at the top and bottom of each column and both ends of each row also rhyme.)
