Colleen came for Kareem in her green and pink jeep at 3:00 p.m.












“See here! Don’t sleep late again, Kareem.”

Four-in-a-Row Reading Game

2 players

Game Preparation:

Print one board

One die

20 pieces of one color for each player (colored disks or "men")

How to Play:

1. Reader rolls the dice.
2. Reader reads a word from one box with the same number as the die.
3. If the reader reads the word correctly, he places a board piece on the square.
4. The winner is the first one to have 4 in a row in any direction: vertically, horizontally, or diagonally.
