 "It says, 'Don't be late! The **competition** starts at 4 o'clock. Don't miss the **action**.' "

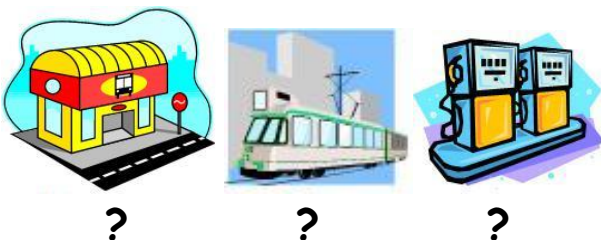


"How do we get there??"
